

**BOARD REQUIREMENTS CONCERNING APPLICANTS THAT HAVE TAKEN
EXAMINATIONS FOR THREE OR MORE TIMES UNSUCCESSFULLY
(Effective September 2014)**

THREE FAILURES: (CANNOT TAKE AGAIN WITHIN 12 MONTHS)

Any applicant who has a combined record of three failures (to include unexcused absences), is required to complete the following in order for consideration to be given for reseating:

1. Submit a re-exam form with application fee.
2. Complete supplemental form to update experience
3. Submit evidence of successful completion of a programmed refresher course taken within 12 months of last seating of the exam. This course must be at least 16 weeks (4 months) in duration and designed primarily to improve proficiency with the specific exam in which the applicant has failed. (This refresher course of study may include documented self-study that was completed).

The Applicant Must Not Have Taken This Course Previously.

FOUR or MORE FAILURES: (CANNOT TAKE AGAIN WITHIN 12 MONTHS)

Any applicant who has a combined record of four or more failures (to include unexcused absences), is required to complete the following in order for consideration to be given for reseating:

1. Submit a re-exam form with application fee.
2. During the 12 months since last taking the exam, applicant must complete a course of study in the technical areas where deficiency was identified to the applicant on previous exam results. The course can be taken through a technical society or a university that gives a final grade, and examination, or some other method used to show course competency. Proof of completion letter is required prior to Board review for seating.
