Field surveys that define the boundaries of conservation easements are required to meet the *Standards of Practice for Land Surveying* in North Carolina as contained in section .1600 of the Board Rules. In addition, the requirements of G.S. 47-30 must be met if the map is to be recorded.

The interpretation protects the public by assuring that the limits of the conservation easement are accurately defined in the survey and the corners are monumented, thereby protecting the legal rights of both the landowner and the conservation easement holder.

The mapping of conservation easements shall be done by, or under the responsible charge of, a PLS.
